Day-by-Day in Detail

April 27th - Today we will depart and fly to Dallas, TX. Our deluxe motor coach will meet us on arrival and take us to the hotel, where we will check-in for our 2-night stay. The afternoon is at your leisure to get settled and explore the hotel. Tonight's included dinner will be at a local restaurant.

April 28th - After breakfast, we will depart for our "Presidential Day in Dallas". A local guide will join us for a Dallas City Tour, showcasing sights such as: Perot Museum, Pioneer Plaza, American Airlines Center (home of the Dallas Mavericks [NBA] and the Dallas Stars [NHL]), the Deep Ellum neighborhood, and Thanks-Giving Square. The tour will also include sights & locations forever tied to the tragic events of November 22, 1963 and the assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy – Dealey Plaza, Texas School Book Depository, the Presidential Motorcade Route, and JFK Memorial Plaza. Following an included lunch, we will arrive at The Sixth Floor Museum for a self-guided tour. Later, we will travel northeast of Dallas to the Hollywood-Famous Southfork Ranch – At one time, there was not a more important question posed to TV viewers than "Who shot J.R.?" Now, we get to explore the ranch that the Ewing's called home for thirteen years, on a guided tour, followed by a delicious barbecue dinner in one of the many extravagant rooms of the mansion. Following dinner, we will return to our hotel for our last night in Dallas.

April 29th - Today, we will explore Dallas & Fort Worth, "The Cowboy Way" – Following breakfast, we will get to experience a real treat for any NFL fan, a VIP tour of AT&T Stadium – Home of the Dallas Cowboys. This tour can include the press box, post-game interview room, locker rooms, Jerry Jones' office and field access, amongst other stadium areas, not usually accessible to the general public. After the tour, we will head to the Historic Fort Worth Stockyard District, where you will have the afternoon to explore and have lunch on your own. We will rejoin as a group later this afternoon for a step-on guided tour of the Fort Worth Stockyard, followed by a viewing of the afternoon cattle drive. We will then board the bus and make a dinner stop en route to Waco, where we will check-in to our hotel.

April 30th - Wake up refreshed in Waco, TX — A small Texas town, most recently made famous by Chip & Joanna Gaines and their HGTV hit series, Fixer Upper. After breakfast, we will head to the Magnolia Market at the Silos, where you will have ample free time to explore the shops and gardens, grab lunch from one of the many on-site food trucks, then stop into the Silos Baking Co. for a sweet treat. This afternoon, a step-on guide will take us on a Waco & HGTV Tour around town, pointing out some of the homes that have been featured on Fixer Upper, as well as a stop at Harp Design, before heading back downtown for a tour at the Dr. Pepper Museum. The remaining afternoon & evening will be yours at leisure, ending with a group farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

<u>May 1</u>st - Following breakfast, we will board the motor coach and travel back to Dallas for our return flights to Ohio, arriving this evening.
